It was moved by Counc. Cliff sec'd by Counc. Ledger and resolved Counc. Spratt alone dissenting to invite tenders for continuing the ditch on the Hartland road about 20 chains - Plans & Specifications to be seen at Mr. John Woolfords and Counc. Cridland.

It was resolved to invite tenders for improving the grade of Hoisting road near the Municipal boundary particulars to be obtained at Counc. Spratt

It was Resolved to invite tenders for hauling 200 yds gravel from the Pit on Edmonds Street to spot on the Hoisting road between the tramway crossing and the Wise road and 200 yds between the Tram crossing and the
