The Statutory meeting of the Municipal Council of the District of Burnaby was held in the Public School house Hastings road on Monday 18 Jan 1894 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon

Present Reeve Schon and Councillors Cridland Stride Cliffe Sprott

Mrs H H Ledger Councillor elect for ward 17 who was present declined to make the requisite declaration until he had made further inquiries

The Clerk reported the result of the election of persons to form the Municipal Council also that the members of the council who had taken their seats had made the Statutory declaration

The minutes of last meeting 2nd inst were read and adopted as read The Auditor presented his report with statements as required by Municipal Clauses Act 1896 and it was moved by Councillor Sprott seconded by Councillor Stride resolved that the report & statement be advertised also that the Clerk make enquiry as to the cost of doing so and report at next meeting

It was moved by Councillor Cliffe seconded by Councillor Sprott resolved that an Advt be inserted once each in the New Westminster Columbian inviting Applications

for the position of collector for the Corporation the applicant to state terms and qualifications and must agree to furnish Bonds of some guarantee Association to the amount of \$2000- the applications to be in not later 2 p.m Saturday the 18th January

Mr H.A. Eastman was elected to make the Assessment of this District for the Current year

It was moved by Council Stride seconded by Council Spratt resolved that the Clerk write to Gilley Bros requesting them to take care of their dog which is reported to be dangerous

A Report from Wm Bailey Special Constable was read and received and he was instructed to continue on till the end of this month on the same terms as before

It was moved by Council Stride seconded by Council Cudland resolved that the Statute Labor By law be repealed

The Reeve reported having received a letter from Mr Chrysler complaining about a tree having fallen across the Boundary road and Council Stride agreed to attend to having this tree removed. The Contractor who had improved the ditch on this road had left some of the dirt taken out on the road and the Reeve & Councillor Stride & Cudland were appointed a committee to attend to this matter - the following
