The Council met in the Clerks Office  
New Westminster City on Saturday 18  
Sept 1894 at 2-30 p.m.

All the members of the Council were  
present

The minutes of last meeting & which  
were read and adopted

Counc Sprott Reported that he had let a  
Contract for cutting off the brush on the  
Hootings road between Still creek bridge and  
the bottom of Welshs hill to Thruswell & Burgess  
for \$450 and the report on motion was  
received and adopted

The tenders received for cutting the brush  
on the Westminster Vancouver road were  
then opened and considered and contracts  
awarded to Del ford & Franklin from  
Boundary road to Royal Oak for \$1200  
and to Thruswell & Burgess from Royal  
Oak to Granway track for \$1500

The Council then discussed the  
estimate of the amt to be expended in  
the different wards together with the  
amounts which have already been spent  
out of this years Revenue.

It was considered advisable to spend  
further in Ward I \$500 in Ward II \$600  
in Ward III \$500 in Ward IV \$500 in  
Ward V

It was Resolved that tenders be invited  
by Adot in next Mondays Columbian  
for furnishing slaying a lot drain or <sup>2</sup><sub>3</sub>  
Avenue Specifications to be seen at  
Counc Cliffs and tenders to be in before

18 Sept 1899

4 pm 24 inst

It was Resolved that Rene Schon  
and Councilors Spott & Hedge be  
appointed as a Committee to view  
the Hastings road as to repairs  
needed and Report at next meeting  
also that Councils Slide & Criddle  
be a Committee on the Vancouver  
road and report at next meeting.  
The Clerk was instructed to write  
to the City Clerk of New Westminster  
accepting on behalf of this Council  
the invitation to be present at the  
Royal Agricultural and Industrial  
Exhibition from the 5<sup>th</sup> to the 8<sup>th</sup>  
October 1899

The consideration of Mr Aulay  
Morrison's Res and a communication  
from Mr J. Woodlands were deferred  
till next meeting of the Council  
The Council then adjourned  
till Friday 24 inst at 4 pm.
