The minutes of last meeting ^{do.} 13 inst were

A Communication from Dr Walker M. A
Officer was read Dr Walker reported that
the supply of water furnished to the dwellers
in the boarding house of the Com. P.W. Co
and some of the adjacent houses was appar-
-ently polluted by passing by Chinese shades
and having the water used in J. Reichenbach
Slaughter house turned into the Ravine
which conveys the water and it was moved
by Counc. Sproth & by Counc. Criddle and

and Resolved that the Clerk be instructed to write to Mr Pickenback forbidding him to pollute the stream and to write to the Consolidated RR Co suggesting to them that they furnish a pure supply of water by sinking a well or some other means. Council Stride reported a man (supposed to be a Finn) had been injured while working in the woods

that the man was not crippled but would like to see a doctor and it was moved by Council Cridland sec by Council Spoth & resolved that Mr Walker be requested to pay the man a visit

The Day Sale Bylaw was read a second time

Council Cridland Reported as to some work that was needed on some roads in Ward I and Council Cridland & Stride were empowered to let a small contract on road near St Vancouver and attend to having some dangerous trees felled also to obtain a screen & have some gravel screened for use on the Vancouver road near the Royal Ced, and may hire a team and two men two days — Council Cliff Reported that the ditch on 4th Avenue and the roadway of 3rd Avenue needed some work and it was moved by Council Stride sec by Council Cridland that Councilors Cliff Spoth & Ledger be a committee to report on these at next meeting the council then adjourned till Saturday 27th Feb 1897 at 2 p.m.
