The Council met in the clerks office
New Westminster City on Saturday the 20
Nov 1894 at 2 p.m.

Present Councillors Cliff Criddle
Sprott & Slade

The Reeve not being present it
was resolved that Councillor Slade take
the chair

The minutes of last meeting were
read and approved

Council Sprott reported as to the Clayton
road and that tenders had been
invited and received to grade this piece
of road after the tenders had been
opened and discussed the tender of
D Thurnell to make the road for \$4-
per chain & 20 cent for culvert was
accepted

Reeve Schon entered the room
and took the chair

The tenders received for continuation
of 1st street to New Westminster City limits
were opened and the tender of J de Wekerell
to do the work for \$4.45 per chain was
accepted

Councillor Cliff Reported for the Committee
appointed to visit that J A Dennell had
agreed to do the work needed on 3rd
Avenue for \$89- the sum of his tender
and that he had been given the contract
On motion the report was adopted

The matter of the length of the bridge to come
was built by C Swart was brought up for
discussion and it was resolved that the

It was Resolved that no more
contracts be let to C Swart
It was Resolved that Councillors
Cridland & Stride be authorized to let
the job of improving the
Booth ditch
Councillors Cridland & Stride were
requested & authorized to make
arrangements with W Wilson
contractor for part of the Jubilee road
so that he may complete & finish
the small piece near tram line not
yet made or contracted for
It was Resolved that tenders to
be in before 2pm 4th December next
be invited by one insertion each
in the Weekly World & Columbian
for furnishing and laying on the
Moscrop road about 10 chains of 10ft
Corduroy also for about 10 chains 10ft
Corduroy on Boundary road Specification
to be seen at Councillors Cridland or
Sprott & on Bulletin board C P P.
A communication from Mr Bailey
was read this was in the matter of
having names placed on the Provincial
Voters list, And the Clerk was instruc-
ted to inform Mr Bailey that
D Robson Esq of this place Provincial
Collector of Voters would give him any
information needed and also furnish
forms for Registering Voters

It was moved by Councillor Stride se^d by com^c
Sprott & Resolved that Mr Hastings and the
collector be instructed to send notices
to some of the delinquent Bay payers
requesting an early settlement of the amounts
due by them.

Council Stride was authorized to let a
contract for about 2 chains Corduroy on the
Wine road.

It was Resolved that an advertisement
~~be inserted~~ inviting tenders for felling
some trees on the Hastings road near some
bridges be inserted with the other advertisements
ordered Particulars to be obtained from
Councillor Sprott & tenders to be in before
2 p.m. 4th Dec next.

It was moved by Councillor Cridland se^d
Councillor Stride & Resolved that the Clerk be
instructed to write to Mr Martin and
warn him not to burn down any more
trees on the road limits.

See motion th Council then
Adjourned till Saturday the 4th Dec next
at 2 o'clock in the afternoon.
