

The Council met in the

on Thursday ^{no} 27 July 1894 at 4 p.m.
There were present Revere Salmon in the
Chair and Councillors (Cresland Cliff
Stride & Spratt

The minutes of last meeting 16 inst
were read and adopted

A petition from Geo. H. Keefer Alex. McKay
& others was read - This was a request that
the Council would accept the grant of
10 ft off the sides off 1 of blocks 14-15-38
& 39 of the small holdings in lot 153 D.I.
so as to secure a 20 ft right of way for a
public road

Communication from the Deputy
Commissioner of R. & W. approving of this
grant were presented read and after
the matter had been discussed it was
moved by Counc. Cliff secondly Counc. Stride
& resolved that the offer be accepted & the
road gazetted and made when funds are
available

The Reeve Reported that the Royal
Oak road was encumbered by growth
of bracken & grass and Comr Stude
was empowered to have the road cleared
It having come to the knowledge
of the Council that the Bygones road
& ditch had been injured - It was
// moved by Comr (rialand sec'd by Comr
Stude & resolved that the Clerk be
instructed to write to Messrs Gilleys bro
and request them to repair the Bygones
road & ditch which have been
injured by their logging operations
The Council then adjourned
at 2 pm of August next
