The Council met in the Clerk's Office
New Westminster City on Saturday 23rd
Oct 1897 at 2 pm.

The Reeve being absent it was
Resolved that Counc Cliff take the Chair
The minutes of last meeting on 16th inst.
were read and adopted.

The Tenders received for secondary
works were then opened & after being
considered the following were accepted
W Wilson to build the remainder of
the Jubilee road for \$3,40 per chain
Whiting Bros to improve the grade
on the Hastings road by making a cut
on the hill for the sum of \$112

Reeve Schron entered the Room and
took the chair

Geo Love + C M Nicholson to haul and spread about 200 cubic yds of gravel on the Hastings road between Dramway crossing and the Wire road for thirty-
(34) seven cents per yard

Geo Love + C M Nicholson for hauling & spreading about 200 yds gravel on Hastings road between Dramway and Casgard road of fifty-four (54) cents per yard.

E Easthope Jr to haul about 300 yds gravel & spread same on Hastings road beyond Still Creek for sixty-five (65) cents per yard.

E Easthope Jr to clear and grade part 3rd Avenue for \$84.

John Woodland to deepen about 20 chains of Holland ditch for \$40.

Council Cliff reported having let a contract to E Easthope Jr to make a short ditch & culvert on May street for \$18. and on motion the Report was adopted

It was Resolved that Tudden be called for making the McKay road between Vancouver road & tram line. The road to be 14 ft wide with 2 ft ditches. Specifications to be seen at Council. Criddle and Tudden to be in the Clerk's office before 2 pm. E. Nov next. Council Slide stated that complaints had been made as to there being no light shown of a night when the grading was being done on the Vancouver Road.

And Commr Stride was empowered to purchase the lanterns and oil needed
It was Resolved that the Council meet at Commr Cridlands on Thursday 4th Nov next at 10 A.M. in the matter of some roads

The Clerk was instructed to write to the B.C. Electric Ry Co and request them to replace the plankings alongside the rails of their track on the Vancouver road

Also to write to Wintermute Bros requesting them to remove the log left by them on Cumberland road

It was moved by Commr Cridland seconded by Commr Cliff & resolved that Commr Stride be authorized to let a contract to haul onto and spread on the Vancouver road 200 cubic yds gravel

The Council then Adjourned till Saturday 6th Nov next at 2 p.m.
