The Council met in the usual place  
on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> April 1894 at 2 o'clock  
in the afternoon

Present Reeve Schow & Councilors  
Cliff Cridland Leagar Spruth & Stride  
The minutes of last meeting on the  
10<sup>th</sup> inst were read and adopted

Counc Stride was authorized to let  
a contract for hauling about 20 cubic yds  
of gravelly dirt onto the Macadam on the  
Vancouver road

The Reeve read a letter he had received  
from MRR Austin Councilor of Coquitlam  
Re Bridge on North road The letter was  
received & filed and further consideration  
of the matter deferred until Coquitlam  
Council is heard from

Counc Cridland Reported that he  
authorized by last meeting he had let a  
contract to Mr Jno Woodland to replace the  
old sills of the bridge on the North Arm  
road near Mr Woodland place for  
\$150 this being the lowest tender received

Mr A Dew Hazard Collector Reported  
that he had received since last report  
\$152.47 on account of post-due taxes

The Clerk was instructed to obtain from  
the Provincial Collector a list of the  
lands in Burnaby sold at the recent  
Govt Sale and the names of the purchasers  
The Clerk having reported on the State of  
the Corporation's Finances it was moved  
by Counc Spruth & by Counc Cridland  
resolved that no more contracts be let
