The Council met in the Clerk's Office
New Westminster City on Friday 24 Sept
1894 at 4 pm.

All the members of the Council were
present

The minutes of last meeting ^{tho} were
read and adopted

Specifications for improving the grade
on the Vancouver road were laid before
the Council and it was resolved that
tenders to do this improvement be invited
by advertisement in the World & Columbian
Specifications to be seen on the road
and work to be completed within 21 days
of letting contract

Tenders received for furnishing & laying
a box drain on 3^d Avenue were opened
and considered and it was Resolved that
the tender of E Cochrane Jr to construct
and lay the box drain for 10 cents per foot
and dig the ditch for 20 cents per chain
be accepted

In the matter of filling in or budging
the Ravine on the North Arm road near
Woollards it was resolved that alternate
tenders to do this work be invited by
advertisement in Vancouver World & Columbian
Specifications to be seen at the Clerk's

Office and John Woollards
A Petition from L C Hile B Russell
and others was read this was a request
to have Edmonds street in lot 3
continued & made as far as Hastings road
and Councillors Cliff & Stride agreed to lay

Specifications of this work before the Council at its next meeting when the question will be dealt with. Council Clerk was authorized to let at Auction on Monday next 26th inst at 8 A.M. to the lowest bidder a Contract to dig ditch on 4th Street. It was resolved that tenders be invited by Advertisement in the Columbian ~~Man~~ ~~World~~ ~~World~~ for some improvement to the grade of Hoatings road near the westerly boundary of Burnaby Specifications to be seen on the spot.

Mr Aulay Morrison M.P. addressed the Council and stated that his Bill in Burnaby vs Ford included all charges that he might have against this Corporation up to the date of the Act.

The Council then Adjourned till Saturday 2nd October at 4 p.m.
