at 2 p.m.

All the members of the Council were present
The Minutes of last meeting held on the
20th inst were read and adopted as read

The Clerk was authorized to place the Seal
of the Corporation of Burnaby on the list
of past due taxes on lands owned by
J. R. Blood so that Mr Morrison can take
proceedings to collect same

Report of Spur Bailey Special Constable
was read The report stated that the water
furnished to the boarding house of the
Power house of the Consolidated Ry Co
and other houses contiguous thereto was
polluted by the ditch or drain from
Rechenbachs Slaughter house being carried
into the Ravine which supplies the water
furnished by the Consolidated Ry Co
Mr J Rechenbach who was present
promised the Council that he would
carry out the suggestion of Dr. Walker
M.H.O in this matter

tenders received for some on the North
Arm road and felling some marked trees
on the road limit were then opened and
after being considered it was resolved that
the tender of Ralph Robinson to do the work
for \$14,50 be accepted

The Reeve agreed to write to Mr Thos Kidd
M.P.P. for the District and request him
to urge upon the Govt the repayment
by them of some proportion of the amount

It was Resolved that a final notice be sent to the delinquent tax payers before the Tax Sale Bylaw is read a third time

It was Resolved that Accts be paid only on the first meeting of the month
Communication from Mr. Tom Hida M.P.P. acknowledging receipt of copy of Resolution Re Coast. Trolley Railway was read and on motion Read & filed

It was Resolved that the following amount be paid

- \$ 60- Mr. Eastman Assessor
- \$ 18- Mrs. Bailey Constable
- \$ 31.15- Al Smith M.C. & Sundries

It was resolved that the 16 Cubic yds of broken stone that Mr. Stewart wishes to sell be purchased at 1.35 per yard

It was moved by Counc. Spoth sec'd by Counc. Fredland & resolved that 200 yds broken stone may be purchased at \$1.50 per yard 100 yds to be within 100 yds of Hooling's road and 100 yds within 100 yds of Vancouver road and not more than 10 yds to be purchased from one man all stone to be small enough to pass through a 2 1/2" ring

This offer for the purchase of broken stone to remain open for one month only
It was moved by Counc. Fredland sec'd by Counc. Cliff & resolved that Counc. Stride be authorized to let

Contract for 3 chains of 16 ft. Corduroy
near the City limits - and Council (Cliff

It was moved by Council (Cliff see by Council
