All the members of the Council were present. The minutes of last meeting the 15<sup>th</sup> inst were read and adopted

A Communication was read from Mr Y R Glover City Clerk of New Westminster in the matter of Burnaby having a Celebration Bonfire on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June and after the question had been fully discussed it was Resolved that a Childrens celebration be arranged for that day and the Clerk was instructed to inform the City Clerk of New Westminster accordingly

The Council decided to meet near the Royal Oak at 4 o'clock p.m. next Saturday to view the roads in the locality and come to some decision as to what may be needed and at 4 p.m. of the same day to have a general meeting at the West Burnaby School house to make arrangements about the Celebration
