The question of Mr H. H. Hedger having been legally elected Councillor or not was brought up and the clerk was instructed to obtain an opinion from Mr Harrison M.P. in this matter so that the question may be considered at next Meeting of the Council. The clerk was instructed to obtain from Mr Harrison. Draft of a Tax sale By Law to be submitted at next meeting of the Council — the applications for the position of Collector which had been received were opened and taken under consideration and on a Poll being taken Mr A. B. Hayward was declared to be elected for the position and the clerk was instructed to request Mr Hayward to attend next meeting of this Council.

The Revere reported for the Special Committee that a contract had been let to Mr Ralph Robinson to do the work needed in the matter of the improved ditching on the Oxbow road for \$200 and it was moved by Counc. Stride sec by Counc. Sprouth & resolved that the Report be received and adopted.

A communication from Mrs Walmley Widow was read this was a request that the Council would pay \$10 to her so that she might be able to pay her rent and it was resolved that her request be granted.
