The Council met in the Clerks Office New Westminster City on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> Sept at 2 p.m.

All the members of the Council were present.

The minutes of the last meeting 21<sup>st</sup> Aug last were read and adopted as read.

The tenders Reid for the continuation of the Jubilee road to the tramway track were opened and after being considered the tender of W Wilson to do the work for \$90 was accepted.

The following amounts were ordered to be paid to the person or persons as named.

the Hastings road near Welsh and  
employ 4 days labor

Councillors Sprott & Ledger were  
requested to see about some mending  
required by corduroy on the Hastings Rd  
It was Resolved that \$1.45 with \$1.50 for  
this labor be the rate at present

Councillors Ledger & Sproth were requested to see about the trees on the Johnston road also to attend to having the brush cut on the north road

Counc Stude was empowered to let by Auction the cutting off of the brush on the Vauc<sup>r</sup> road from tram Junction to the boundary

It was Resolved that Councillors Sproth & Cliff let the job of cutting off the brush on the Hastings road from Still creek hill to Welsh hill Counc Cliff was authorized to employ about \$150 worth of work on 3<sup>d</sup> Avenue by day labor he was also authorized to call for tenders and Auction off about 14 chains of ditching on 3<sup>d</sup> Avenue near Creaseys

It was Resolved that the date fixed on or before which rates must be paid to obtain the Rebate be extended till Saturday next 11<sup>th</sup> inst

The Council then adjourned till Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> inst at halppost two in the afternoon
