

5th June 1894

The Council met in the West Bunnaby School house on Saturday the 5th June 1894 at 7 p.m. All the members of the Council were present

The Council having in the forenoon viewed the proposed roads to afford access to some of the small holdings - discussed the question and resolved to defer taking any action until more funds are available

The matter of the Celebrations on the 22nd inst was considered and it was Resolved that to postpone the consideration until next meeting of the Council when it was expected a local Committee would report

It was Resolved that the Council Adjourn to meet again in New Westminster City on Saturday the 12th inst at 2 p.m.
