The Council met in the
Clerks Office New Westminster
City on Saturday 13 Aug 1898
at 4 p.m.

Present - Reeve Schor and all
the Councillors

The Clerk being absent through
illness the Reeve kindly took notes
of the meeting

The reading of minutes of last
meeting was on motion of Councillor
Stride & Sprott postponed to next
meeting of the Council

A letter was read from Mr
E M Wiltshire of Clayton applying
for a loan from the Sinking Fund of
£250 on ten acres of property
owned by him at Burnaby lake

It was resolved the property being
practically unimproved on the motion
of Councillor Sprott se^cly Councillor Stride
that the application be declined
It was resolved on the motion of
Councillor Byrne se^cly Councillor Sprott

15 Aug 1895

That Councils Cliff & Smith report to the next meeting a plan and Specifications for the improvement of Third Avenue. It was Resolved on motion of Councillor Smith secy council Cliff that a Cheque be drawn for \$800- and \$31.85 interest to date being the balance due Bank of Montreal of Temporary Loan.

Temporary loan
Resolved on motion of Councillor Smith secy council Cliff (partly moving)

a Sub Committee to report with regard to Jesse Lores contract sections 5 & 4 of the South road now under construction & that Councillor Byrne be instructed to draw up for the next meeting of the Council a plan and Specifications for a short bridge required on the North Arm road near Mr. Macniss house and that Councillor Byrne also report to next meeting a plan for a short extension of the Holland road ditch cost not to exceed \$25-

A Letter received from Mrs. Blinleyson was read - This was a complaint of the state of the side road leading ~~from~~ from Hastings road to her house

13 Aug 1898

It was Resolved on motion of Councillor Smith & Councillor Byrne that Councillor Stride be instructed to have the road repaired by day work.

It was moved by Councillor Smith & Councillor Byrne & Resolved that Councillor Sprott bring in a Specification to the next meeting for a slight further regarding graveling of the further end of the Hastings road.

The Council then on motion of Councillors Cliff & Sprott adjourned till Saturday 27 inst at 1 p.m.
