

18 June 1898

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The Council met in the Clerks Office  
New Westminster City on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup>  
June 1898 at 4 p.m.

All the members of the Council  
were present.

The minutes of the last meeting  
first were read and adopted.

It was Reported that the BC  
Electric Ry Co had constructed a  
Switch on the W & V road without  
first having obtained permission  
from the Council to do so and the  
Clerk was instructed to obtain from

our Solicitor an opinion as to the  
legality of the Electric Ry Co's Action  
Counc Cliff & Mr Haszard were request-  
ed to ascertain the line of third 5<sup>th</sup>  
Avenue and boundaries of same.

The Tenders received for some improv-  
ements to the grade of the Royal Oak  
road were then opened and after  
being discussed it was Resolved  
that the following be accepted,

Whiting Bros to make the cut for  
\$125- and W & B Ledger to haul the gravel  
onto the Corduroy for 45 cents per cubic  
yard.

Rever Schow left the chair and  
Counc Smith was elected Temporary  
Chairman.

Counc Byrne Reported on the Tenders  
received to cut ditch on Wiggins road  
deeper and relay the Corduroy and  
on Motion of Counc Slide & Sprout

15<sup>th</sup> June 1898

it was Resolved that W H Ledger  
be awarded the contract at \$5-<sup>00</sup> per  
chain work on new ditch & \$3 per chain  
for deepening old one

It was moved by Counc Byrne  
sec'd by Counc Spratt & Resolved that  
the Committee appointed (Councilors  
Cliff Smith & Byrne) on the 4<sup>th</sup> inst  
view & report on ditch on Third  
Avenue & Mary Street

The Council then Adjourned  
till 2 pm of Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> July next
