Council by one presented specifications

A communication from D. McCallister

was instructed to notify the present occupier
that the premises must be cleaned up
and the charge suggested by the M.H.C.
made and if no attempt is made
within the next 14 days to comply
with the M.H.C. instructions that steps
will be taken to compel attention & same
Under a suspension of the Rules for order A
Road Tax By law was passed through
the necessary readings to be reconsidered
and finally passed at next meeting
The Clerk was asked to see Mr Arthur
Shepherd and obtain from him a list

The Collector was authorized to
have the Collector's roll divided up
into more convenient books

It was moved by Councillor Cliff
and by Councillor Sprott resolved that the
Clerk be instructed to write to the
Municipal Council of New Westminster
City suggesting the need of an Electric
street light on Mary street near the
northerly boundary of the City

It was Resolved that the
Solicitor be requested to attend to
having the Tram Co replace the
flanking alongside the rails of the
track on the public roads in
this District

Councillors Cliff Byne & Sprott
were appointed a Special
Committee to let a contract
for not more than 10 chains
of Corduroy on Third Avenue

The Council then
adjourned till 2 p.m. of
Saturday the 5th of March
next
