

19 November 1898

The Council met in the Clerk's house
12th St. corner 4th Avenue on Saturday the 19th
November 1898 at 2 p.m.

Present, Reeve Schow in the chair and
Councillors Ryne, Spott, Cliff, Stride and
Carter Smith,

The minutes of last Council meeting
- 5th inst. - were read ~~and~~ and adopted.

Mr. W. Maxwell Smith, who was present
presented to the Council a letter from him-
self, agreeing to furnish the nails and
labour needed to lay a four feet wide side
walk, from the Post Office to the B. C. Electric
R. Central Park, if the Council will furnish
the lumber, and, after discussing the
question, it was moved by Counc. Spott
seconded by Counc. Cliff and resolved
that a committee, consisting of the Reeve
and Counc. Carter Smith & Stride, be ap-
pointed to obtain the price of side walk
lumber and what the tram. company will
charge for carrying the lumber onto the spot.

It was resolved that \$300. be
borrowed from the Bank of Mont.
under the Temporary Loan by Law
to pay int. due 1 Nov. on \$10,000 De-
bentures.

Counc. Stride presented specifications for some improvement to the Gipl ~~road~~ road and tenders rec? for doing this work, and it was moved by Counc. Pyne seconded by Counc. Cliff & resolved that E. Easthope Jr. tender to do the work for \$13.50 be accepted.

It was moved by Counc. Carter Smith & Spott and resolved that Counc. Stride and Pyne be authorised to let a small contract for work on the Boundary road near the tramway crossing.

Counc. Pyne agreed to bring in, at next meeting of the Council, specifications of continuation of Jubilee road.

Mr. Austin Councillor of Coquitlam offered some suggestions as to repairs needed on the North road, and it was moved by Counc. Cliff seconded by Counc. Stride and resolved that Coquitlam Council be authorised to have work done on the North road the cost not to exceed \$75, to be equally divided between Coquitlam and Burnaby.

Counc. Stride reported that George Hardy had repaired the Finlayson?

Mr. A. de W. Hazard was authorised to obtain from the Prov. Gov. copy of list of lots in Burnaby, sold at the Prov. tax sale ~~and~~ which had been redeemed by Burnaby.

Counc. Pyne was requested to make arrangements for having the tail drain to the Holland road ditch cleaned out.

The Council then adjourned till Saturday.
