Specifications to of some improvements to Third Avenue were laid before the Council.

Counc Carter Smith Reported that he had examined Third Avenue where Mr Cressy had fenced in part of the roadway which he had previously cleared and recommended that Mr Cressy be paid \$12- for his work on Third Avenue.

It was Resolved that the clerk be instructed to invite tenders by advertisements in the Weekly Columbian and Semi Weekly World for some clearing on the Burnet road Specifications to be seen at clerk's office for some work on the Hastings road Specifications to be seen at Council Sproth's Residence and on the road and for cutting and grading Third Avenue Specifications to be seen at Clerk's Office Tenders to be in by 6 pm, Saturday 3rd Sept next the lowest or any tender not necessarily accepted Council Slide Reports that so far he had been unable to attend to repairing of side road leading to Mrs Fink's house
