

3<sup>rd</sup> Sept 1898

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The Council met in the Clerk's Office New Westminster City on Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept 1898 at 2 pm

There were present Reeve Schow in the Chair & Councillors Stride Carter Smith & Sprott

The minute of meetings held on 13 and 27 Aug were read and adopted

Counc Stride Reported that he had employed John Ledger to clear out the W & V road and chop & remove dangerous birning trees at a total cost of \$4.40 and the report was received and adopted

It was Reported that a Telegraph Co was having erected on the W + V road that would interfere with traffic on the road and the clerk was instructed to inform the Telegraph Co. that all Telegraph poles must be placed at least six feet from the ditch on the side of the road and not on the road. The tenders received to do some improvements were opened and dealt with as follows:

The Council met in the Clerks office, New Westminster City, Saturday 3 Sept. 1898 at 2 p.m.

President Reeve Schow in the chair, & Counc. Stride, Carter Smith & Spott.

The minutes of meetings held on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of Aug. last were read & adopted.

Counc. Stride reported that he had employed John Ledger to clear out the W & V road and fell & remove the dangerous burning tree, at a total cost of \$4.40 and the report was received & adopted.

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It was stated that a Telegraph P<sup>o</sup> was having poles erected, on the W + V. road, that would interfere with traffic on the road, and the Clerk was instructed to inform the Telegraph P<sup>o</sup> that all telegraph poles must be placed at least six feet from the ditch on the side of the road and not on the road.

The tenders received, to do some improvements, were then opened and dealt with as follows;

George Hardy's tender to clean and grade Third Avenue for \$7.50 per sh  
Whiting Bros. tender to make the cut on the Hastings road for \$100 and  
John Wedgers tender to brush out the Barnet road for \$34, were accepted.

The Clerk was instructed to write to the Poquitan Council, and enquire what they proposed having done to improve the North road.

On motion of Council. Spott & Carter Smith the tax sale by law was read a first time and then a second & third time and passed.

The Council then adjourned till Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> inst. at 7 p.m.
