Love for \$3,951 per chain and the Report

The Clerk Reported that he had written
to the Proprietors of the Slaughter house
at Central Park requesting them to
comply with the instruction from Dr
Walker M.H.O. of this District but
so far had received no reply

steps with a view to having his orders
about the Slaughter house carried out
if necessary by enforcing the Law
that applies

Solicitor who seemed doubtful of the

& Smith were appointed a Committee
to report at next meeting

finally passed and ordered to be

required by Law.
