The Council met in the Clerk's Office New Westminster City on Saturday ⁴ May 1898 at 2 p.m.
There were present Rev. Sabour in the chair & Councillors Byrne, Stride, Smith & Scott.

The minutes of last meeting ^{to} were read and adopted.

The Clerk reported that Mess Wilson & Bentler had on behalf of the Hon Jas Reid C.E. Perkins Capt James Leman C.D. Dunn and Stramberg with drawn notices of appeal against the decision of the Court of Revision and that no other notices had been served.

Council Byrne reported that Mr C.D. Dunn had complied with the wishes of the Council and intended that portion of the North Arm road which had been injured by removal of gravel too close to the road.
