

OCT 14 1899

The Council met on Saturday Evening
14th Oct. at 7.30 p.m. in municipal Hall.

Present Reeve Schou in the Chair and
a full Council.

The Reeve reported that he had instructed
the Clerk to call this Special meeting, as
it was necessary to consider questions
in connection with the forthcoming Tax Sale.

Couns. Smith & Stride submitted a plan and
specification for erection of the anubuilding on
the Hall lot, and stating that they had, as
requested, obtained tenders for the work. on
motion the tenders were ordered to be opened &
were as follows:-

It was moved & seconded by Couns. Cliff &
Smith and resolved, that ^{Layfield's} ~~Mowbray's~~ tender be
accepted, he being a ratepayer & his tender
not being 5% above the ~~other~~ other tenders.

The work to be completed within 15 days from
signing Contract.

It was moved & seconded by Couns. Spratt &
Smith and resolved that the Clerk write
to the B. C. Electric Ry. Co. notifying them
that they must replace the planking
alongside each rail of their tracks on
the Vancouver Rd. in accordance with their
agreement with the Corporation, and that
the switch on Edmonds St. near the Douglas
Road, must be planked & ballasted up
level with the road bed.

The Council considered the matters in connection with the forthcoming tax sale and decided to request the collector to finally wind up sale on Tuesday week next by offering all unsold lots on the list, absolutely without reserve, with the exception of 8 lots of large acreage on which was fixed a reserve of Two Dollars per acre, the Collector to buy in for the Corporation any lots not disposed of.

The Council adjourned to meet next Saturday 21st Inst. at 2.30 p.m.
