

SEP 16 1899

The Council met on Saturday Evening,  
16<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1899 at 7.30 p.m. in Municipal Hall,

Present Reeve Schow in the Chair and  
Councillors Byrne, Stride, Cliff, Smith, & Spott.

Minutes of last meeting were read &  
were on motion adopted.

The matter of awarding the contract for  
cutting the hedger ditch was discussed,  
and the tenders, which were opened at  
last meeting, were considered. The written  
tenders were from Whiting Bros. \$160<sup>00</sup>  
and W. H. Smith \$175<sup>00</sup>. Mr. Hedger had  
previously, in open Council, made a  
verbal tender for \$125<sup>00</sup> but as objection  
was made to this tender not having been  
submitted in writing, it was moved &  
seconded by Couns. Byrne & Stride that  
the matter be laid over until Mr. Hedger  
had agreed, in writing, to contribute  
\$25<sup>00</sup> in Cash towards the work. Carried.

Couns. Byrne submitted a specification  
for a bridge on the North Arm Road,  
and it was moved & seconded by  
Couns. Cliff & Byrne & resolved that  
tenders be called for building same,  
specification to be seen at Mr. Throssell's  
house, & tenders to be in by opening of  
next Council meeting, the Clerk to advertise  
same in Weekly Columbian & World.

A petition was read from the rate payers & residents in that part of the Municipality adjacent to the north of New Westminster City requesting the Council to approach the New Westminster City Council with a view to compel the B. C. Electric Ry. Co. to give service in compliance with their charter, as there is now no service between 8.30 am & 7.30 pm.

It was moved & seconded by Couns. Byrne & Stride & resolved that a deputation consisting of Revere Schow & Couns. Cliff be appointed to lay the matter before the City Council next Monday Evening.

Couns. Spratt submitted a specification for cutting brush on the Hastings Road from the top of Still Creek Hill to Boundary Road. It was moved & seconded by Couns. Byrne & Smith & resolved, that tenders be called for performing the work, tenders to be in by opening of next Council meeting, and specification of work to be seen at Couns. Spratt's house.

On motion it was resolved that tenders be called for houghing out Vancouver Road as follows:- Section 1. from Post office, Central Park, to Royal Oak. Section 2. from Royal Oak to Junction of tramway lines. Tenders to be in by opening of next Council meeting and specifications to be seen at Central Park, Post Office.
