

OCT 21 1899

The Council met on Saturday, 21st Oct. 1899.
at 2.30 p.m. in Municipal Hall.

Present: Reeve Schow in the chair &
Councillors Stode, Sprout, Smith, & Cliff.

The minutes of the two last meetings were
read & were, on motion, adopted, after
correction.

A communication was read from the
Coquitlam Municipal Council requesting
the Council to co-operate with them in
obtaining an amendment to the "Thistle
prevention Act" so as to include other
noxious weeds. It was moved & seconded
by Couns. Smith & Sprout & resolved
that the communication be received &
that the Coquitlam Council be requested
to communicate with this Council at a
later date, before the next session of
the House, and this Council will
co-operate with them as desired &
will communicate with Mr. J. Kidd M.P.P.
laying their requirements before him.

A communication was read from the
Medical Health Officer, Dr. R. E. Walker,
stating that the nuisance committed
by Chinaman on Wise Ranch, had been
abated. Received & filed.

It was moved & seconded by Couns.
Sprout & Smith & resolved that a cheque
be drawn for Three Hundred Dollars, in

favor of Bank of Montreal in
 payment of Coupons due 1st Nov: next.

On motion it was resolved that in the
 absence of Couns. Byrne, the above
 cheque be signed by Couns. Spratt, as
 acting Chairman of Finance Committee.

It was moved & seconded by Couns.
 Spratt & Smith & resolved that the
 Clerk be instructed to write to
 the Hon. Prov. Secretary, again
 requesting the appointment of Mr. D.
 Coulter as a Provincial Constable.
