

AUG 26 1899

The Council met on Saturday Evening 26<sup>th</sup> Aug: 1899 at 7.30 p.m. in the Municipal Hall.

Present Reeve Pehou in the Chair, and a full Council.

The Minutes of last Meeting were read, and were, on motion, adopted.

Counc: Stride reported that W. Cressy would proceed with the sinking of the well on Monday next.

The Sub-committee who were appointed to report re nuisance on J. U. Wise's property was, on motion, granted further time.

A communication from the South Vancouver Municipal Council was read, re needed repairs to bridges on Boundary Road and offering to assume half cost of same. Counc: Stride reported that in accordance with instructions, he had inspected the bridges and had found that slight repairs were needed, but that the bridges were not, as reported, in a dangerous condition, and that he had ordered the performance of such work as would be sufficient <sup>for</sup> present requirements. Moved and seconded by Counc: Byrne & Smith & resolved, that the report be adopted and that the Clerk acknowledge receipt of above communication.

A Communication was read from Mr. Joseph Peirson re Tax Sale notice on the Brine-Bales property. The Communication was, on motion, ordered to be received & filed and the Clerk to acknowledge.

A Communication was read from the A. A. & J. Soc. soliciting a contribution of Fifty Dollars towards this year's Exhibition. Moved & seconded by Couns. Smith & Cliff & resolved that the communication be received & laid over till next meeting.

On motion it was resolved that the Reeve be respectfully requested to insert advertisements in the Vancouver papers, stating that an agent of the Corporation would attend at Mr. C. S. Douglas' office in that City, on two days in the coming week, for the purpose of supplying full particulars to intending purchasers at the Tax Sale.

The Clerk was also instructed to obtain & forward to the Reeve fifty copies of the Tax Sale advertisement.

Mr. Frodsham addressed the Council on the matter of the taxation on his property.

The Council adjourned to meet next Friday 1<sup>st</sup> Sept. at 7. p.m.
