

JUL 29 1899

The Council met on Saturday 29th July
1899 in Municipal Hall at 2.35 pm.

Present Reeve Schon in the Chair &
Councillors Byrne, Cliff, Smith, Sprott & Stride

Couns. Smith & Stride reported that they
had, on behalf of the Council, accepted
the municipal hall building from Contractor
Allen on Wednesday last. It was moved
& seconded by Couns. Cliff & Byrne &
resolved: that the report be adopted and
their action approved.

A communication from Dr. A. E. Walker,
Medical Health Officer, reporting re
nuisance committed by Chinese; the Clerk
reported that, acting under instructions
from Counc. Cliff, he had written formal
notice to the Chinaman, ordering him to
abate the nuisance and to make certain
alterations on his premises, and that
Counc. Stride had personally served said
notice on the Chinaman. On motion the
matter was left in the hands of the
Lab. Committee to attend to.

Couns. Byrne reported on behalf of
the Committee to whom was referred the
petition of W. Branderth for a new road
through part of Lot 25. Counc. Byrne stated
that the road requested was a continuation
of Frost Street for about 16 chains and an
offset of nearly 4 chains to the corner of

Boardreth's lot, but that it could not be continued farther as it would cut through private property. It was moved & seconded by Counc. Byrne & Cliff & resolved that the said road be built as soon as the collection of taxes justifies the taking up of newwood.

on behalf of the Committee to whom was referred the matter of opening up the Johnston Road, Counc. Cliff reported that the Committee had met at the time and place appointed and there being only one tender in, the contract was awarded to F. Throssell for the sum of Fifty Dollars, the work to be undertaken without delay and in accordance with the specification.

Moved & seconded by Counc. Sprott & Strode
^{& resolved}
that the action of the Committee be approved.

A communication from the Deputy Provincial Secretary was on motion ordered to be received & filed and the Clerk to acknowledge.

A communication from Morrison & Doctrell re arrears of taxes on Edmonds property, was on motion ordered to be received & filed.

A communication from the Collector was on motion ordered to be laid on the table.

A communication from W. W. Haynes, in which he offered the Council the use of a house on his property, was on motion ordered to be received & filed & the Clerk to acknowledge

thanking him for his offer.

The Reeve reported that the bridges on the Boundary Road were in need of repairs and on motion Counc. Stride was empowered to have necessary repairs effected.

The Clerk reported re Booth & Robinson overdue mortgages. It was moved & seconded by Couns. Byrne & Smith & resolved, that the interest on Booth's mortgage be reduced to seven per cent, providing he will sign an acceptance of the offer, and that the interest on Robinson's mortgage be also reduced to seven per cent providing he will sign an acceptance of the offer and will renew the expired insurance on his building.

Moved & seconded by Couns. Byrne & Sprott & resolved: That Couns. Stride & Smith be a committee, with power to act, for the purpose of sinking a well on the Municipal hall lot.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to attend the office in the Municipal Hall every Monday instead of Fridays as previously.

The Council adjourned to meet on Saturday fortnight 12th Aug. at 7 o'clock.
