The Council met in the clerks house, on Saturday 4th Feby 1899 at 2 p.m.

All the members of the Council were present.

The minutes of last meeting, 21st ult^o, were read and adopted.

The Reeve reported that he had ordered a Seal & small seal to be used on official letter paper &c for the sum of \$25, and on motion of Deunes, Byrne and Cliff, the report was received and adopted.

the offer was accepted.

It was resolved to advertise, in the
Columbian and News Advertiser, for
tenders to build the municipal hall,
the tenders to be sent in before 12
o'clock noon 18th inst.

The Reeve reported that he had
been unable to attend the meeting
in Victoria, about the Trunkroad,
and had telegraphed his inability
to attend.

It was moved by Coume. Cliff
seconded by Coume, Carter Smith
and resolved, that the Reeve be
requested to write to Messrs. Kidd
and Cotton M.P.P. requesting to
have inserted in the Estimates ~~an~~
a grant of \$2,000 to improve the
Westminster & Vancouver road.

Coume. Cliff reported that some
repairs to the North road were badly
needed and the Reeve was requested
to write to Coquitlam Council in
this matter.

The Council then proceeded to
deal with the election of Assessor
& Clerk. There being only one applica-
tion for the position of Assessor Mr.
H. A. Eastman he was so appointed.
After several ballots had been taken
for the position of Clerk Mr. H. J. H.
Shirley was declared to be elected.
The reading of the Temporary Loan
By Law was postponed.
