The Reeve verbally reported that the Council had this day visited the several Wards of the District & had obtained information as to the wants in the different localities, and were left open for further consideration, except that the Council had agreed to pay W. Feedham the sum of Seventeen  $\frac{50}{100}$  being half cost of deepening & straightening side drain, leading the road water off Vancouver main road, said payment being subject to the work being done to the satisfaction of the Council. The Council had met the Reeve & Councillors of Coquitlam on the Forth Road, which is under joint control of the two Councils and after considering several needs decided to postpone, until receipt of further funds, the sanctioning of further expenditure on said highway. Moved & seconded by Couns. Cliff & Byrne & resolved that the report be adopted.

Moved & seconded by Couns. Smith & Cliff & resolved that the Collector be instructed to fix the date of the Tax Sale for Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> Sept. next at 10 o'clock a.m. & Collector to issue notices in accordance with the requirements of the law.
