

OCT 7 1899

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The Council met on Saturday, 7<sup>th</sup> Oct 1899  
at 2.30 pm in Municipal Hall.

Present Reeve Schon in the Chair &  
Councillors, Cliff, Smith, Stride & Spratt.

The minutes of last meeting were read &  
were on motion adopted.

The matter of awarding the Contract for  
making the Brandreth Road was taken up  
and there was found to be only one tender  
in, namely from Thos: a Fennell for \$6<sup>00</sup>  
per chain. It was moved and seconded  
by Couns. Cliff & Spratt, & resolved  
that the tender be accepted.

The tenders were opened for making  
pathway from Municipal Hall to  
Junction of Tramway lines, and were as  
follows:-

Geo: Hardy	20.00
Fred: Thruswell	16.00

It was moved and seconded by Couns. Smith & Sprout and resolved that Throssell's tender be accepted.

The manner of awarding the Contract for cutting the Ledger Ditch was taken up, and there being only one tender in, it was opened & found to be as follows:- from W. H. Ledger for \$150<sup>00</sup> he also agreeing to donate the sum of \$25<sup>00</sup> towards the work. It was moved & seconded by Couns. Smith & Cliff and resolved that the tender be accepted & Couns. Sprout to superintend the work & see that it is properly performed.

A communication, accompanied by a specification, was read from the South Vancouver Council re repairs to Boundary Road. Received & filed.

An account from the Royal City Planning Mills for lumber supplied to Throssell for use on bridge on North Arm Road, was read, and it was moved & seconded by Couns. Cliff & Smith & resolved, that the amount be held back from Throssell's Contract unless he shall have discharged the account before the completion of his Contract.

The Council adjourned to meet on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> Inst. at 2.30 p.m.
