

SEP 9 1899

The Council met on Saturday Evening  
9<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1899 at 7.30 p.m. in the municipal hall.

Present Reeve Schaw in the Chair and Councillors  
Byrne, Stride, Cliff, Smith, & Sprott.

The minutes of last meeting were read, and  
were on motion adopted.

The Reeve reported that he had written to the  
South Vancouver Council, asking to arrange  
a meeting of members from each Council, for  
the purpose of inspecting the Boundary Road,  
but that, so far, no arrangement for such  
meeting had been made. On motion the report  
was received and adopted.

The Clerk reported that acting on instructions,  
and finding the power granted in the  
Mortgage deed, he had renewed Insurance  
on R. Robinson's house. On motion the report  
was received and adopted.

Collector Mr. Dermott reported that he had  
refunded the amount of road tax to E. Blair,  
and it was on motion resolved that the cheque  
that has already been issued for this purpose,  
in favor of E. Blair, be amended in favor  
of Collector Mr. Dermott.
