

MAR 14 1900

The Council met on Wednesday  
14<sup>th</sup> March 1900 at 3.30 pm. in  
the Municipal hall.

Present Reeve Schou in the Chair  
and Couns. Byrne, Stride, Cliff  
and Sproutt.

The minutes of last meeting were  
read and approved.

Counc. Sproutt reported that he had  
let a contract for spreading 22 yds.  
of gravel on Hastings road at 43  
cents per yard, the next lowest tender  
being 49 cents. on motion the report  
was adopted and contract approved.

Counc. Sproutt submitted a specification  
of work required to be done on the

Stasgard road. The same was approved and Couns. Cliff and Spratt were empowered to call for tenders and award contracts on the ground, on the following Monday at 9 A.M.

A Communication was read from the North Pacific Lumber Co. Received & the clerk instructed to reply that the Council will raise no objections to the granting, by the Government, of foreshore rights of lot 213 and East half of lot 214.

The Reeve reported that all the members of the Council, except Counc. Smith, had visited the Byrne Road, and had found dangerous washouts, caused by the late excessive rains, and they were of the opinion that the necessary repairs should be effected. The Council had also inspected the new Wiggins road, and found that about 25 chains of corduroy were required to make the road passable. It was, on motion, resolved to call for tenders for relaying corduroy and repairing said roads.

Counc. Byrne was instructed to call for tenders for clearing out ditches on the North Arm road.

It was, on motion, resolved to call for tenders for the supplying of one hundred yards of screened gravel, to be delivered, within 2 weeks,

at places on the Vancouver Rd. within a quarter of a mile of the gravel pit, according to the directions of Council. Stride who was empowered to award contracts if any tender received was for one dollar, or less, per yard.

It was resolved that the Reese and Council. Sprout and Byrne be a committee to inspect the Vancouver, Statch and Hastings roads, and to report at the next meeting as to the work required thereon.

Council. Cliff was empowered to repair box drain on Sixth street.

The Clerk was instructed to request the B. C. Electric Ry. Co. to fill in with rock a drain on the Vancouver Road near the slaughter house.

The Clerk was instructed to write to Lee Dean, notifying him to take steps to prevent the water from his land overflowing and destroying the surface of Vancouver Road.

On motion it was resolved to hold the Court for the Revision of the Assessment roll on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

The Meeting adjourned to meet on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> April 1920 at 2.30 pm.
