

The Council met on Saturday 15th Sept. 1900.
at 2.50 pm in Municipal Hall.

Present:-

Rever. Schou in the Chair & Counc. Byrne
Storde Smith & Sprott.

The minutes of last meeting were read & were,
on motion, adopted.

A Communication was read from the Coquitlam
Council stating that the Council was not in a
position to proceed with the big fill on the
North Road, but wished for the joint
Councils to make the small fill and asking
this Council to take hold of the work.
on motion the communication was received and
the Clerk instructed to reply that the Council
objects to entertain the proposition and
suggests that the temporary road now in
use be utilized until such time as Coquitlam
Council is willing to conform to the proposition
originally agreed to, as this Council is of the
opinion that by performing a part of the
work only, and completing at a later date

it would involve an extra & unnecessary outlay, and, owing to the nature of the work, would, at best, make but a patched and unsatisfactory job.

Coun. Sprout reported re roadway for Hastings road that he had only received one tender, viz. from W. Hedges at \$5⁰⁰ per chain, and considering it a fair offer, he had awarded the contract. On motion the report was received and the contract approved.

Coun. Smith reported that he had written to Mr. Green manager of the Lumber mill at Barret notifying him of the illegality of drawing heavy loads with narrow tires, and also notifying him that one of his teamsters had knocked the railing off a bridge and that he would be held responsible for replacing it, and for any accident that might arise from its displacement. The clerk was instructed to also write, warning Mr. Green that the log chute across Barret road must not be used until permission has been obtained from the Council.

A communication was read from Morrison & Dockrill re confirmation of Tax Sale, and was, on motion, ordered to be received & filed and the clerk instructed to reply.

The Municipal Electors' By-law was, on motion, re-considered, signed & sealed.

The Pound By-law was read and was advanced several stages.

Coun. Stude was empowered to obtain 100 cubic yards of cracked rock for Ward 2 at 1.50 per yard, within three months from date.

Coun. Sprott was requested to interview road inspector J. Sprott re Boundary road repairs.

The Council adjourned to meet again on Saturday 6th Oct. at 2.30 pm.
