The Council met on Saturday
21st April 1900 at 3 pm in Municipal
Hall

Present:

Reeve Schou in the Chair & a full Council.

The Minutes of the previous meeting
were read & were, on motion, adopted.

The Reeve reported that he had
received from J. W. West a
conveyance of 12 ft. of B. 14 lot 143,
from G. Cartell to the Corporation,
said strip of land to be used for
the public road known as the
McKay road. The report was
received and the Clerk was
instructed to have the conveyance
registered.

The Reeve reported re Jubilee road
extension, and it was moved &
seconded by Couns. Sprott & Smith &
resolved: That the Council agree to
abandon that short length of the
Hatch road lying between the Easterly
side of the Jubilee road and the
Vancouver road, at Central Park,
in consideration of W. Hy. Town
gazetting a continuation of the
Jubilee road to the Vancouver road,
and of W. E. Parkinson completing
said extension, to its intersection with
the southerly side of the Vancouver road,

and the Council agrees to gazette the abandonment of said portion of Hatch road at such time as it may be required. The Clerk was instructed to notify Mr. E. Parkinson to this effect.

On motion, it was resolved, that the Court of Revision, to be held on Saturday next, shall consist of the Reeve & Couns. Storde Spratt, Cliff & Byrne, and the Clerk was instructed to request the Corporation Solicitor to be present.

Counc. Byrne reported re fixing North Arm Road that F. Throssell had tendered to perform the work for thirty Dollars, and on motion it was resolved that the tender be accepted.

The Reeve retiring, on motion it was resolved that Counc. Cliff take the Chair.

It was moved and seconded by Couns. Smith & Byrne and resolved: That Counc. Spratt be empowered to have 8 Chains of corduroy laid on Hastings road, at same price as before.

On motion it was resolved that next Saturday be pay day.

The meeting adjourned to meet on Saturday next 28th Inst: at 1.30 pm.
