The Minutes of the two last Meetings
were read and were on motion adopted.

A Communication was read from W.
A. B. Dixon, returning officer for Richmond
Reading, for enclosing cheque for Ten

Dollars for rent of Hall for taking the poll on election day. on motion the same was ordered to be received & filed and the Clerk instructed to acknowledge.

Counc. Spratt reported that the Committee appointed at last meeting to investigate Mr. W. C. Dermott's case had met as arranged but that Mr. W. C. Dermott did not appear, and the Committee asked for further time to report. on motion the report was accepted and request granted. It was arranged for the Committee to meet again on Tuesday next at 8 o'clock P.M. on motion it was resolved that the Committee consist of the whole Council & with full power to act.

on motion it was resolved that the Contract awarded to W. C. Hedger for digging ditch from Hedger road to Buttraby Lane be cancelled. The Clerk was instructed to notify Mr. Hedger.

The Councillors discussed the matter of road repairs necessary in their respective wards, and in each case the matter was left over for further consideration.

on motion it was resolved that Counc. Byrne be requested to call

for tenders for brushing out the North
 Arm Road, the same to be submitted
 at next meeting.

The Council adjourned to meet again
 on Saturday 7 July at 2 o'clock p.m.
