

MAR 24 1900

The Council met on Saturday, 24<sup>th</sup> March 1900 at 11 o'clock a.m. at Thecove.

Present Reeve Ashton in the Chair and a full Council.

A communication having been received from the North Pacific Lumber Co. stating that the late heavy rains had caused very serious washouts on the Barnett road, the Clerk had been instructed by the Reeve, to call the Council together for the purpose of inspecting the road, and advertisements had been inserted in the Columbian and Province, requesting any parties desiring to tender on the work required to be done, to meet the Council at Thecove.

On motion it was resolved that after drawing up a specification of necessary repairs, to call for tenders for effecting the work, in block, and to accept if any be considered reasonable, and if not that Council. Smith be empowered to call for tenders, to be in at next meeting.

The Council made an exhaustive inspection of the road from Thecove to the Hill, and there

being only one party present to tender,  
 it was decided not to award a  
 contract but to leave the matter  
 in the hands of Council Smith as  
 previously arranged, with power  
 to act.

The Council returned to  
 Aliceville and the meeting  
 adjourned.
