

The Council met on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1900 at 7 pm in J. S. Annandale's store New Westminster.

Present:-

Reene Schan in the chair & a full Council.

Coun. Smith reported that he had instructed the Clerk to call this special meeting as he had been notified that the Govt. grant for the improvement of the Vancouver road was available and that it was the wish of the authorities that the Council should proceed with the work.

On motion it was resolved that the improvement and widening of the Vancouver Rd. be commenced, firstly, from the Boundary Road to the Royal Oak road, and that the road when completed be 30 feet between ditches, and that the widening thereof be effected on the South side, and that a committee of the whole Council visit the site and lay off the work in about 20 chain sections, and prepare plans & specifications to lay before next Council meeting, preparatory to letting the work by tender.

The Pound By law was considered in a committee of the whole Council with Coun. Sproull in the Chair. The committee rose & reported progress.

The meeting then adjourned.
