The Council met on Saturday, 4 Aug. 1900
at 8 pm in Municipal Hall.

Present:-

Reeve Schow in the Chair & a full Council.

The minutes of last meeting were read
and were on motion adopted as amended.

Coun. Stride reported that the necessary
alterations had been properly effected
at Reichenbach's slaughter house.
on motion the report was received & adopted.

Coun. Stride also reported re S. Shepherd's
application for a road, that he did
not consider a road necessary, as
the property already had a road frontage.
Report received & adopted, and the
Clerk instructed to reply to this effect.

On motion the Clerk was instructed to

write to Roadley & Co. of Vancouver notifying them to at once remove all stones and rubbish deposited on Edmonds st. and to inform them that no sand gravel or other material must be removed from the Road limits, or any matter deposited thereon

A Communication was read from the Matagui Council, respecting formation of a deputation to wait on the Government for the purpose of amending the tax sale law. On motion it was resolved that Coun. Sprout be a delegate on said deputation, but that it is the opinion of this Council, as there is not much chance, owing to the shortness of the session, of any remedial legislation being effected at the present time, that there should be a meeting of the Reeves of the different Municipalities, to consider this & other matters of importance, and prepare them in proper shape to lay before the House at a later date.

A communication was read from A. Speck re needed road repairs. Referred to Council. Byrne to draw up a specification, and to report at next meeting.

A. S. P. A communication was read from Mr. W. H. Meary, requesting contribution towards the R. A. & S. Soc. prize list. on motion it was resolved that the sum of Thirty Dollars be donated.

A communication was read from the Reeve of Chilliwack, requesting the Council's endorsement of a petition for the construction of the Coast-Kootenay Railway. The Clerk was instructed to reply that the Council regrets that they cannot accede to the request, for whilst approving of a railroad through the Fraser Valley, they consider that construction from Coast to Kootenay would involve an expenditure beyond the powers of the Province.

A communication was read from Mr. J. W. West, enclosing map of lot 32. and

requesting map of Municipality in exchange. Received & filed and Clerk instructed to forward map as soon as possible.

The Clerk was, on motion, instructed to write to Mr. Thos. Davis requesting him to remove the planking across the roadway, opposite his gate, as complaint had been made that it was dangerous to traffic.

A Communication was read from the Clerk of the New Westminster Council, expressing regret that gravel had been removed from Burnaby for use on City Streets, without first obtaining sanction, and requesting permission to remove such further amount as may be required. The Clerk was instructed to acknowledge, stating that permission was granted, and that in future it is the request of the Council that permission be obtained before removing any gravel or other material, so that the Council can indicate the location from which the material can be removed.

A Communication was read from the Coquitlam Council re repairs to Bridge on North Road. The matter was referred to Couns. Byrne, Smith & Cliff to draw up a specification of the work and the Clerk to call for tenders by
