

The Council made an inspection of the Vancouver Rd. improvements on Saturday 13th April in the fore noon & afterwards met in the Municipal Hall at 2.30 p.m.

The minutes of previous meeting were read, and were, on motion adopted.

Coun. Howe reported that he had called for tenders for culvert & ditch on Fourth St. and had obtained the following: Geo. Davis, \$15⁰⁰; J. Fennell \$16⁰⁰. & had accepted the former. On motion the Report was received and adopted.

Coun. Byrne submitted a specification for improvement of Cook Road, which was read & approved. The Clerk was advertize for tenders for the job, to be in at next meeting.

The matter of the extension of the Royal Oak road was taken up and the Clerk was instructed to write to Mr. J. E. Harris, offering Sixty Dollars for a 33 ft. right of way, and sufficient land to swing the present road to the East side of his lot, being sub. div. 6 of Div. Lot. 98.

Coun. Smith reported re North Road line, and was granted further time to complete his report.

A communication was read from H. McKee re needed repairs to North Road. Received & filed & the matter left in the hands of Coun. Smith to act with Coun. Austin of Laquetlam.

A communication was read from the N. Westminster City Council, enclosing copy of a resolution passed by that Council re Vancouver road. The thanks of the Council were tendered to the City Council for the hearty manner in which they had taken up the subject, and that the Council was awaiting the result of the application to the Government for a grant for the completion of the improvement of that road.

Coun. Love submitted a Specification for improvement of Third Avenue. The Clerk was instructed to call for tenders by advertisement, same to be in at next meeting.

Coun. Spott submitted specification for hauling & spreading macadam on Hastings Rd. & he was empowered to call for tenders & award contract.

On motion it was resolved that the
 Court of Revision of the Assessment
 Roll shall consist of the Reeve &
 Councillors: Byrne, Stude, Smith & Spratt.

The Council adjourned to meet on
 Saturday 4th May after the close
 of the Court of Revision.
