

2<sup>nd</sup> November, 1901

The Council met in the Municipal Hall at 2:30 P.M. on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> November Present. Reeve & Chou in the Chair, and a full Council.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and on motion adopted.

A letter from Mr J. E. Keefer asking for extension of time to complete the McKay Road contract, was read, and it was moved by Councillor Byrne, seconded by Councillor Spratt and carried, that time be extended until 1<sup>st</sup> December conditional on there being no further delay.

Mr J. R. Grant's letter received at last meeting asking for confirmation of lines of North Road touching his property was again taken up for discussion. It was finally moved by Councillor Byrne, seconded by Spratt that the Clerk write to Mr Grant informing him that the Council had accepted Mr Still's survey, and thought the Corporation had no further responsibility in the matter, but in the meantime had directed the Clerk to write to Bogart's Council on the subject asking that Corporation to unite with us in adopting Mr Still's survey. Carried.

Another letter from Mr Grant asking that some interest be taken off of arrears of taxes due on property held by him, in consideration of a large sum of arrears being paid was read, and the Clerk was directed to reply that Council regrets having no legal authority to comply with request. Moved by Councillor Spratt and seconded by Councillor Hyde. Carried.

Councillor Hyde reported that the Electric Tram tracks had been raised to an obstructive height near Mr Booth's place on Vancouver Road near New Westminster City limits. It was moved by Councillor Byrne, seconded by

Coun. Love, that Couns. Stride and Smith be a committee to inspect said obstruction with power to act. Carried.

The Road Tax Collectors report (was received and filed.

The Health officers letter in reference to the old slaughterhouse at Central Park was considered, and it was moved by Coun. Byrne, and seconded by Coun. Stride and carried, that the clerk write to owners of said property, telling them of Dr Walker's report, and asking for prompt action on their part.

The Constable reported all quiet in Burnaby, and submitted for the inspection of Council a portion of his equipment, a pair of handcuffs.

It was moved by Coun. Stride and seconded by Coun. Smith and resolved that Coun. Byrne be authorized to expend a sum not exceeding Ten dollars in improvement of First Avenue near Mr S. Farrand's.

Moved by Coun. Byrne, seconded by Coun. Stride that about twenty yards of Mr Stewart's broken rock be obtained at One <sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollar per yard for use in Ward Two. Carried.

It was moved by Coun. Byrne, seconded by Coun. Stride and resolved that tenders be called for ditching on North Crown River Road, and for widening Royal Oak Road (new part) to meet the Vancouver Road.

Specifications for the former to be seen at Councilor Byrne's, at the Crown Road and for the latter on front of Royal Oak Hotel advertisements, calling for tenders to be

inserted in the Province and Columbian newspapers.

Moved and seconded by Couns. Smit and Love that Coun. Byrne be empowered to have culvert attended to at St. E. Corner of District Lot 99. Carried.

It was moved by Coun. Byrne and seconded by Coun. A. Ride and resolved that time limit on Vancouver Road Improvement North side be fixed at 20<sup>th</sup> December.

- Ditto for Hastings Road gravel contract 68<sup>00</sup> per 100<sup>00</sup>
