

The Council met at 7 P.M. Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> Saturday, in the Municipal Hall.

The minutes of the two previous meetings were read and on motion adopted.

A letter from Boquitham Council calling attention to the necessity of repairs on Brunette River bridge and agreeing to bear one half of the cost if Burnaby Council would have the necessary work done, was read, and it was moved by Coun. Love, seconded by Coun. Stride that Coun. Love and Smith be a Committee to inspect said bridge with power to act carried.

A letter was read from The Electric Tram Company agreeing to grant to Council a right of way over their Road on Edmonds Street for a small nominal sum. The Clerk was directed in accordance with resolution moved by Coun. Stride and seconded by Coun. Spott to write to the Electric Tram Company accepting the conditions proposed, and asking the Company to have the agreement made out and forwarded to our Corporation for signature.
