An adjourned meeting of the Council was held in the Municipal Hall on Saturday November 19<sup>th</sup> 1910.

1438. John B. Amos requesting additional \$250 as Deputy Returning Officer for fetching ballot box.  
Moved by Councillor Heil  
 seconded by Councillor Goldicott  
 that C.W. Amos be allowed mileage  
 on motion being put Councillors McKee  
 Stride and Rumall voted against  
 the motion.
1439. Moved by Councillor McKee  
 seconded by Councillor Stride that no  
 one be allowed additional \$2.50  
 on motion being put Councillors  
 Rumall Heil and Goldicott voted  
 against the motion.
1440. Moved by Councillor Stride seconded  
 by Councillor Goldicott that letter be

 that the Council do not feel disposed

1441. W.J. Holdom requesting road to be  
 cleared in front of Lots 10 & 11 Block 1  
 D.L. 12<sup>y</sup> and lots 147 Block 4. D.H. 12<sup>y</sup>.  
Referred to the Councillor for the Ward  
and the Engineer.
1442. T.L. Macpherson requesting permission  
 to temporarily appoint Draughtsman  
 at \$3<sup>00</sup> per day to bring Hall map up to  
 date Referred to the Board of Works

1443. W. Gouster with reference to account for broken rock and interest on taxes.

Resolved that W Gouster be notified that the council consider that he has no claim.

1444. H.P. Kidal & Co with reference to acting as Customs Brokers.

Resolved that reply be sent asking for particulars in regard to rates.

1445. American Life and accident Insurance Co, requesting orders given by Municipal Employees to be deducted from wages.

Resolved that the council deduct the amount from all men signifying their willingness to pay same.

1446. W.J. Ross Hon Sec. Ward 2 Ratepayers Association enclosing copy resolution passed in regard to hecklers driving by autoists on Vancouver Westminster Road.

Referred to the Police board to take steps to stop nuisance and a committee of Councillor Hill Reeve & Clerk empowered to write after asking Ratepayers association to make suggestions to remedy the matter.

1447. L.D. Garnross Secretary Surrey Board of Trade forwarding copy resolution passed by Surrey Municipal Council

asking Provincial government to assist in opening and improving the Lower Valley Road.

Resolved that the petition be endorsed by this Council.

1448. Tenders for clearing boulevard on Barnet Road were referred to Councillor Hart Rumsey and the Engineer.

Tenders for clearing boulevard on Sun Road were referred to Councillors McKee and Goldicott.

Tenders for clearing boulevard on 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue (City) were referred to Councillors Gregor Stade and the Reeve.

Tenders for clearing boulevard on Hamilton Road were received from

Stewart & Jackson	\$8.00 per chain
J. Campagne	\$3.50 do.

Resolved that the tender of J. Campagne be accepted.

1449 Resolved that the Council endorse the action of the Engineer in stopping the work of collecting rock owing to the bad weather and that the work of clearing boulevards be proceeded with preparatory to laying sidewalks.

1450 Resolved that the teams now hauling rock be used in hauling lumber

1451 Resolved that tenders be called for hauling lumber per 1000 feet topsoil designated within a radius of 3 miles of New Westminster to be given on Thursday Nov<sup>r</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> at 5 p.m. and that advertisements be inserted in the Columbian and Daily News.

1452 Resolved that the tender of Mess<sup>r</sup> Johnson & Phillips for labour for sidewalks at \$15<sup>60</sup> and \$13<sup>60</sup> per chain be accepted for the Keefer Road and Guichon Road

1453. Resolved that Clerk write to Coquitlam Council requesting them to gravel the North Road from Forks to Johnson Road as arranged.

1454. Resolved that Mr Chas. Cliff be written to that the Council consider that the water from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue which he claims is flooding his property is a matter to come under the Ditches and Water Courses Act but the Council would be willing to construct ditch through his property providing he is willing to bear half cost and give quit claim to the Council against any damage sustained

1455 Moved by Councillor Rumell seconded by Councillor Stride that the funds of the School Board now in hand be used as a temporary loan of \$650 on account of ordinary expenditure for next year

1456 Moved by Councillor McKee seconded by Councillor Geddes that a grant of \$60<sup>00</sup> be made to the School Board as a contribution towards Christmas prizes and

entertainment for all the children of the Municipality

- 1457 The Water Committee recommended that the rates to parties outside the water area be \$1.50 per month in the absence of meter subject to the usual discount and that they be entitled to obtain such discount for the month of October although not paid by the 10th.
- 1458 The Reeve reported that he had the advice of our Solicitors that it was permissible to clear the boulevards out the Bylaw funds. Report received
- 1459 Resolved that the East Burnaby Well be referred back to the Reeve Councillor Goldicott and the Engineer to report.
1460. Resolved that the question of appointing man to sharpen tools on the North arm Road be referred to the Board of Works
1461. M<sup>r</sup> Atkinson applied for sidewalk on the South side of Third Avenue opposite his property  
Resolved that the matter be referred to Councillor Stride and Goldicott
1462. Moved by Councillor Rumble seconded by Councillor Goldicott that this Council endorse the Petition of the Burrard Inlet Tunnel and Bridge Co to the Dominion government

for a grant of \$300,000 towards the construction of the Second Narrows Bridge.

1463. Moved by Councillor Remond by Councillor McKee that the Blacksmith Helper and Caretakers take all sharp tools and bring back all tools to be sharpened and that they use the Municipal Stars and Rig for that purpose and that the Blacksmith have charge and be responsible.

The Board of Works report was received as follows

An adjourned meeting of the Board of Works was held in the Municipal Hall on Thursday, November 17th, 1910. Present His Worship Reeve Byrne, Councillors Stride, Collicutt, McKee, Hill and Rumble (in the chair).

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

1. Mr. G. R. Gordon & W. S. Rose attended in regard to rock pile on Douglas Head and it was arranged that they should meet committee of Chairmen of Board of Works, Councillors Hill and the Engineer at 2 o'clock at Douglas Road tram station on Wednesday, 23rd inst.

Communications were received as follows:

2. John McLeod and others requesting roadway between D. L. 150 & 175 to be cleared from Boundary Road to Patterson Road which the property owners were willing to contribute 25%.

Resolved that Mr. McLeod be written to stating that the Council is not aware of having built roads on a contribution of 25% of the cost having received as much as 50%.

3. D. Harris and others petitioning for sidewalk on the Byrne Road.

Resolved that Clerk reply stating that appropriation had been made in the By-Law for sidewalk on this road and that steps would be taken to put same down as soon as possible.

4. Ira J. Warmsley to know if water system would be installed by the spring.

Resolved that Mr. Warmsley be notified that committee of Mr. Woart & Mr. George acting with committee of Council have matter in hand and as soon as they arrive at decision they will deal with the matter.

5. Frank Yaeger requesting extension of time under his bonds for building on his property. Referred to Reeve & Clerk.

6. J. B. Wilson & T. A. Allen with reference to gravel taken from North Road.

Resolved that an account be forwarded for \$10. cost of gravel taken.

The Engineer's report was received as follows:-

Municipality of Burnaby.

Gentlemen:-

I beg to submit the following report.

Douglas Road & Vancouver Road.

As there is no money available for further work on these roads it will be necessary to close down the works for the year. Meantime the operations have been confined to collecting rock for these two roads. This rock, I suppose, can be reckoned as an asset.

I have given instructions to close the camp at Still Creek Hill at the end of the month and propose cutting out Lee's gang as soon as the clearing for the sidewalks on the Douglas Road has been completed. As there is no more work meantime for the Engineer on the Road Roller I intend laying him off.

In order to find work for the settlers now working on the Vancouver Road, the clearing for the sidewalks to be laid early next year could be done, provided the necessary funds can be arranged for.

Gilpin Road.

A serious error has been discovered in the survey of the Gilpin Road through the centre of District Lot 63. This portion of the road ~~x~~ should be straight from the Royal Oak Road to where it joins the Clayton Road, but according to the stakes on the ground the road jogs from Block 10 to Block 12 and thence runs straight to the Clayton Road but 33 feet south of where the road should be. As the contractors for the slashing had a large gang at work at different points in this road, the error was not discovered until the work was almost completed. The plan was subdivided in

July 1909 by Noel Humphreys, who should be communicated with regarding the discrepancy.
