- Moved by Mr McGregor, seconded by Mr Stride "That the B.C.E.R Conferring Franchise By Law be introduced and read a first time" Carried unanimously
- Moved by Mr Goldscott, seconded by Mr McGregor "That the B.C.E.R Conferring Franchise By Law do now pass its first reading" Carried unanimously
- Moved by Mr Goldscott, seconded by Mr McGregor "That the B.C.E.R Conferring Franchise By Law be now read a second time" Carried unanimously
- Moved by Mr Goldscott, seconded by Mr McDonald "That the B.C.E.R Conferring Franchise By Law do now pass its second reading" Carried unanimously

- Moved by Mr Goldscott, seconded by Mr Rumble "That the Reeve and Clerk be authorized to sign and seal the Street lighting Agreement with the B.C.E.R Co, subject to an amendment in clause 1 from 1000 to 1500 feet" Carried unanimously.
- Mr McGregor gave notice of motion to introduce a Health By law at the next meeting of the Council
- Moved by Mr McGregor, seconded by Mr Goldscott "That the reports of the Finance Committee of 3rd and 9th October be adopted" Carried unanimously

Moved by Mr. Rumble, seconded by Mr. Strode "that the Report
of the Board of Works of Oct 9th be adopted.

Carried unanimously


Moved by Mr. Goldicott, seconded by Mr. McDonald "that the Report
