

Monday - October 24th. 1913.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, October 24th. 1913, at 9 O'clock. p. m.

Present: His worship Reeve W. J. J. J.

Councillors Mac. Donald, Macpherson, Faulvel, Coldicutt, Mayne, and Stride.

The Appraiser submitted a Report on the application for Renewal of Hunter. J. Brown's Mortgage on Block 46, D. L. 157/153.

Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the existing Mortgages be released.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the Council lend to Hunter. J. Brown, of Jubilee, Burnaby, the sum of \$3,000 from the Sinking Fund, for a period of Three years, the repayment of which sum, together with interest thereon at the rate of Eight per Centum per annum, being secured by a First Mortgage on Real Property held by the said Hunter. J. Brown, and described as Block 46, D. L. 157/153, Group One, M. W. D., the same being assessed, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, at the total sum of \$13,250, according to the last revised and corrected Assessment Roll of the Municipality."

Carried unanimously.

The Appraiser submitted a Report on the application for Renewal of E. E. & J. C. Brown Mortgage on 1/2 of Blk. 55, D. L. 32, by Michael Barry.

Moved by Cr. Macpherson, Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the existing Mortgages be released.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Macpherson - Seconded by Cr. Stride: - "That the Council lend to Michael Barry of 2265 - 8th. Avenue West, Vancouver, the sum of \$1,200 from the Sinking Fund, for a period of Three years, the repayment of which sum, together with interest thereon at the rate of Eight per centum per annum, being secured by a First Mortgage on Real Property held by the said Michael Barry, and described as the North half of Block 55, District Lot 52, Group One, M. W. D., the same being assessed, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, at the total sum of \$4,815, according to the last revised and corrected Assessment Roll of the Municipality."

Carried unanimously.

Messrs. Lennie & Clark served Notice of an Application for the Cancellation of the Subdivision Plan of Blocks 54 and 55, D. L. 31. The Engineer submitted a Report thereon.

Moved by Cr. Faulvel, Seconded by Cr. Mayne: - "That a copy of the Report of the Engineer be sent to the Corporation Solicitors, and they

1 be instructed to take the necessary steps to protect the interests
 2 of this Corporation, along the lines of the said Report."

4 Moved by Cr. Fauvel, Seconded by Cr. Mayne:- "That the recommendation
 5 of the Board of Works, that the East end of Barnet Road be at
 6 once put in a state of temporary repair, at an estimated cost of
 7 \$1090, be adopted."

11 Moved by Cr. Macpherson - Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the request
 12 be granted."

13 Carried unanimously.

14 Moved by Cr. Mayne - Seconded by Cr. Stride:- "That the Council do
