 13 no deductions be made by the Treasurer from the wages of
 14 Municipal Employees, and that no Municipal monies be paid
 15 to the Burnaby Employees Benefit Fund."

17 Moved by Mr. Bevan, Seconded by Mr. MacDonald: - "That henceforth
 18 a fee of \$4.50 be charged for the use of the Public Hall, and
 19 that such fee be charged to all users, without exception."

20 Carried unanimously.

21 Moved by Mr. Bevan, Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: - "That a fee
 22 of \$1.50 be charged for the use of the Committee Room or
 23 any other room in the Municipal Hall."

24 Carried unanimously.

25 Mr. Ward gave Notice that at the next Meeting he would ask
