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3 A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the
 4 Municipal Hall on Monday, July 16th. 1914, at 7.45 p.m.
 5 Present:- His worship Reeve Fraser.

6 Councillors Lomas, Webb, Ward, Van Vel, Mulgrew, and
 7 Murray.

8 Moved by Cr. Ward, Seconded by Cr. Webb:- "That the Minutes
 9 of the meeting of July 3rd. inst., be adopted as written, and
 10 confirmed."

11 Carried unanimously.

12 Correspondence was received, and dealt with as follows:-
 13 Mr. E. Padmore. Thanks for Note of condolence.

14 Moved by Cr. Lomas, Seconded by Cr. Webb:- "That the
 15 letter be received and filed."

16 Carried unanimously.

17 Mr. Holmes. Thanks for improvements to boulevard.

18 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Mulgrew:- "That the
 19 letter be received and filed."

20 Carried unanimously.

21 Dr. G. de B. Watson - re. Burnaby Rendering Co., enclosing copy
 22 of a letter from Dr. Young to himself, together with a copy
 23 of his reply thereto.

19 B.C.C.R. Co. re. Fairview Road Crossing, advising that it
 20 is not considered necessary to have the danger signal
 21 at this crossing, installed at this time.

 23 matter be referred to the Corporation Solicitors, with
 24 instructions to take steps to have this signal replaced."

 33 reference to the North Road Bridge.

38 Finance Committee Report:- Your Committee met on
 39 July 9th, 1914, and recommend:-

1. That General Accounts, amounting to \$3494.00, be paid.
2. That Wages, amounting to \$1335.60, be paid.
3. That the Resignation of Mr. J. Browne, be accepted.
4. That the Requisitions be confirmed.

- 1 5. That this Council offer a standing reward of \$10 to any
 2 person giving such information as will lead to the
 3 conviction of any person breaking windows or otherwise
 4 damaging any public or private property in the Municipality
 5 of Burnaby, and that the Clerk take the necessary
 6 steps to make the same public.
- 7 6. That the Reeve and the Chairman of Finance be
 8 empowered to arrange with the Bank for the financial
 9 requirements of the second half of the current year.
- 10 7. That the matter of the Sinking Fund for By Law 89, be
 11 left with the Reeve and the Chairman of Finance.

Moved by Mr. Van Vel, Seconded by Mr. Mulvey: "That the Report of the Finance Committee be adopted."

Water Committee Report:

Your Committee met on July 9th. 1914, and recommend:-

1. That the Estimate of Work for the two weeks commencing July 16th., amounting to \$124.80, be adopted.
2. That the expenditure incurred during the three weeks ended June 30th. 1914, amounting to \$194.14, be approved.
3. That the application of S. H. Williams for reduction of Water Rates be not granted.

Moved by Mr. Ward, Seconded by Mr. Van Vel: "That the Report of the Water Committee be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

Board of Works Report:-

Your Committee met on July 9th., 1914, and recommend:-

1. That the Estimate of Work for the two weeks commencing July 16th., amounting to \$1190, be adopted.
2. That the Report of the Works Superintendent, on applications, be adopted.
3. That permission be granted to the Deer Lake Lumber Co., to construct and use a Skid road on the East side of Royal Oak Road, south from Grassmere Road, subject to the execution by the Company, of the usual Agreement.
4. That the Salary of T. Atkinson be \$90 per month, as Engineer for Rollers No. 1 and 2, pending a further report from the Works Superintendent.
5. That the recommendations of Col. Tracey, re. work on Barnet Road, be adopted, and the work be proceeded with at once.

Moved by Cr. Murray, Seconded by Cr. Fan Vel: - "That the Report of the Board of Works be adopted."

Moved by Cr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Cr. Somas: - "That the Agreement between the Deer Lake Lumber Co., and this Corporation, re. Skid road on Royal Oak Road, be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Wm. Pattison submitted an offer to purchase Lot 4, Block 9, \$1,294. (Tidball Mortgage) for \$544.25, payable as follows: - \$300 cash and the balance in sums of \$50 every three months with interest payable at the same times, at the rate of eight per cent per annum.

Moved by Cr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the offer of Wm. Pattison be accepted, and the necessary Agreement of Sale be prepared."

Moved by Cr. Fan Vel, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the Resolution re. Tax Sale, embodied in a Minute of the Meeting held on April 16th. 1914, be amended by substituting the words "September 10th" for the words "September 14th".

The Reeve and the Corporation Solicitor reported verbally on the Inquiry now being held by Dr. Shortt, into the affairs of the B. L. & R. Ry. Co., and subsidiary companies.

M^r Lamond of Harrison and Lamond, attended and addressed the Council on the merits of the pavement laid down by his firm.

Moved by Cr. Somas, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the deepest sympathy and condolence of this Council be extended to M^r Kate McLean, on account of the death in action, of her son, Captain Donald McLean."
