

Monday. August 20th. 1914.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, August 20th. 1914, at 7.30 p.m.

Moved by Mr. Murray, Seconded by Mr. Mulgrew:- "That the men be paid at the rate of 40 cents per. hour."

Councillors Ward, Mulgrew, Murray, Webb, and Lomas, voted in favour, and Councillor Faulvel voted against.

McIntosh, who was recently killed in action, and to the relatives of Mr. John. Henry White, who was drowned while on duty as Engineer on a Transport which was torpedoed in the Mediterranean Sea."
