A Special Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, August 6th. 1917. at 10.10 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Grass,
Councillors Lomas, Webb, Ward, Fawcett, Mulgrew and Murray.

Moved by the Reeve, seconded by Mr. Ward: - "That on this anniversary of the declaration of a righteous war this Council records its inflexible determination to continue to a victorious end the struggle in maintenance of those ideals of Liberty and Justice which are the common and sacred cause of the Allies."
