3 A Special Meeting of the Council was held at the
4 Municipal Hall on Wednesday, August 14th. 1918, at 10
5 O'clock, a.m. in pursuance of notice duly served on
6 each member of the Council.

7 The Meeting was called for the purpose of discussing
8 B. C. Electric Railway Company matters.

9 Present:— His worship Reeve Fraser.

10 Councillors Richmond, Webb, Ward, Edgar, Mulgrew,
11 and Murray.

12 The Solicitors wrote, forwarding copy of a Lettergram from
13 the Board of Railway Commissioners, advising that the
14 hearing of the application of the B. C. E. Ry. Co. for permission
15 to increase the fares on the Burnaby Lake Line and on
16 the Colosse Line, had been set down for August 24th.
17 at Ottawa, at 10 a.m.

18 Moved by Cr. Mulgrew, Seconded by Cr. Richmond:—"That the
19 Clerk obtain, if possible, a copy of the Agreement recently
20 made between the B. C. E. Ry. Co. and its employes, as to
21 schedules of wages."

Carried unanimously.

22 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Richmond:—"That a
23 delegation be sent to Ottawa to attend the hearing on
24 August 24th. inst. and that such delegation consist of the
25 Corporation Solicitor, Mr. W. G. McQuarrie, with the Reeve
26 and the Clerk."

Carried unanimously.

27 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Mulgrew:—"That the
28 B. C. E. Ry. Co. be requested to rebuild the Burnaby Lake
29 Station, which was recently destroyed by fire."

Carried unanimously.

30 Moved by Cr. Richmond, Seconded by Cr. Webb:—"That this
31 Council do now adjourn."
