

Wednesday August 14th. 1918.

A Special Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, August 14th. 1918, at 10 o'clock, a.m. in pursuance of notice duly served on each member of the Council.

The Meeting was called for the purpose of discussing B. C. Electric Railway Company matters.

The Solicitor wrote, forwarding copy of a Letter from the Board of Railway Commissioners, advising that the hearing of the application of the B. C. E. Ry. Co. for permission to increase the fares on the Burnaby Lake Line and on the Clunne Line, had been set down for August 24th. at Ottawa, at 10 a.m.

Moved by Cr. Mulgrew, Seconded by Cr. Richmond: - That the Clerk obtain, if possible, a copy of the Agreement recently made between the B. C. E. Ry. Co., and its employees, as to schedules of wages.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Richmond: - That a delegation be sent to Ottawa to attend the hearing on August 24th. inst., and that such delegation consist of the Corporation Solicitor, Mr W. G. McQuarrie, with the Reeve and the Clerk.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Mulgrew: - That the B. C. E. Ry. Co. be requested to rebuild the Burnaby Lake Station, which was recently destroyed by fire.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Richmond, Seconded by Cr. Webb: - That this Council do now adjourn.
